Meeting Minutes
November 14, 2023

A regular meeting of the Royal Oak Crime Prevention Council was held on November 14, 2023, in the Community Room at the Royal Oak Police Department located at 450 East Eleven Mile Road, Royal Oak, MI 48067.

- Resident Amy Hatfield presented an issue with a neighboring house that is being used as an Airbnb and allowing single night rentals and not limiting occupancy or purpose. This has become a “party house” and is a neighborhood nuisance for traffic and noise at all times of the day and night.
 - The resident was seeking guidance regarding her options with this situation.
 - The council suggested she provide some ideas on ordinance restrictions that CPC could help present to the city manager’s office for review.
 - The resident will follow-up with Lindsay.

- Revisions to the Royal Oak Crime Prevention Council are moving forward and including to be renamed the Royal Oak Community Engagement Board.
 - Commissioner Hunt made some suggested changes to the ordinance.

- The City-Wide Block Party is tentatively scheduled for June 11, 2024; Faye will contact Shelly Mazur to confirm date availability and review any conflicts Food Truck Rally’s or other events.
- CPC anticipates a public safety presentation in October 2024 involving police department hot topics or a similar public presentation.
