## **Notice of Construction**

### **Gardenia Avenue**

The city will be resurfacing Gardenia Avenue from just east of N. Main Street to N. Campbell Road this fall. The city recently opted to add this project for 2018 due to the availability of funding for major road improvements.

Construction is scheduled to begin in mid-to-late August 2018 and will be completed by mid-October 2018. Work is not scheduled on Sundays, holidays, or during downtown festivals.

The contractor awarded this work is AJAX Paving Industries of Troy, Michigan. The city has hired Nowak and Fraus Engineers of Pontiac, Michigan to oversee the project on behalf of the city.

#### **Scope of Work:**

- Milling and resurfacing asphalt pavement
- Reconstructing the curved portion of the road just east of Frentz Hardware
- Installation of a “raised intersection” at N. Alexander Avenue to provide traffic calming
- Installation of a pedestrian refuge island just east of N. Vermont Avenue for traffic calming and improved pedestrian crossing
- Replacing handicap sidewalk ramps at intersection corners
- Re-striping the roadway (lane lines, crosswalks, etc.)

#### **Trash Pickup:**

There will be no change in the trash pickup dates and the trash will be taken care of as usual unless otherwise notified. If necessary, the trash may need to be moved by the contractor to the nearest intersection for pickup. **Please have address markings on all trash and recycling containers so they can be returned to the appropriate address.**


#### **Traffic Changes:**

The construction operations will close Gardenia Avenue to thru-traffic and **will prohibit side street traffic from entering Gardenia Avenue between N. Main Street and Campbell Road.**

- Residents south of Gardenia Avenue should use E. Farnum Avenue to exit the neighborhood.
- Residents north of Gardenia Avenue should use 12 Mile Road or Derby Avenue to exit the neighborhood.
- Residents on Gardenia between N. Main Street and N. Alexander Avenue will be able to access their driveways for parking throughout most of the project, though there will be

some delays caused by construction equipment. Drivers should plan to enter Gardenia Avenue via Oakmount Street.

- Residents on N. Connecticut Avenue north of Gardenia Avenue will be able to access their driveways via N. Connecticut Avenue (south of Gardenia Avenue).
