On Wednesday July 27, 2020, the Criminal Investigation Division detective investigated the Larceny from Auto case and spoke with the victim who suspected a possible ex-boyfriend. The suspect was left a voicemail to contact the police department to discuss the stolen \$7,000 dollar Rolex watch.

On July 29, 2020, the victim called the detective assigned to the case to report her stolen watch was returned to her and she did not want to further pursue larceny charges.
