Breaking and Entering

Additional Incidents and Information

Suspect Arrested for Operating While Intoxicated 2nd Offense and Hit & Run

A 48-year-old Royal Oak resident was arrested, for operating while intoxicated 2nd offense and leaving the scene of an accident. On August 24, 2020, approximately 3:45 p.m. Royal Oak Officers responded to a rear-end accident at E. Eleven Mile near S. Campbell. The caller observed the suspect driving away from the scene and was able to give dispatch the license plate number. The officers were able to locate the address from the license plate and observed him pulling into the driveway of his residence.

The officers spoke with the driver who was under the influence of alcohol. The driver had a prior alcohol conviction and was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated 2nd Offense and Hit & Run.

Flee and Elude Suspects Arrested

On Friday, August 21, 2020, at approximately 4:54 p.m., a Royal Oak officer initiated a traffic stop on a 2007 Toyota Highlander for a traffic violation in the area of W. 13 Mile and Coolidge Hwy. The vehicle being driven by a female driver along with a male passenger, pulled into a parking lot. As the officer was speaking to the driver, she quickly sped away on W. 13 Mile eastbound towards Crooks then southbound to W. 12 Mile. The vehicle turned down a dead-end street and both occupants exited from the vehicle running into backyards.

The officers quickly set up a perimeter and were assisted by Hazel Park K9 Unit. The officers searched the area. The suspects were both quickly captured after being found by the officers hiding in different backyards.

The female driver who fled in her vehicle is 36-year-old Kentucky resident Brittany Anne Mundy. She was driving on a suspended license and was in possession of Methamphetamine.

The male passenger gave the officers a false name and was later identified as 40-year-old Detroit resident Davaughn Deshawn Miller.

Brittany Mundy was charged with one (1) count of Possession of Methamphetamine, a felony which carries a penalty of up to 10 years in prison, one (1) count of Fleeing and Eluding-Third Degree, a felony which carries a penalty of up to 5 years in prison and one (1) count of Driving While License Suspended, a misdemeanor which carries a penalty of up to 93 days in jail.

Mundy's has a lengthy criminal history including convictions for felony forgery, possession of heroin, contempt of court, operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol/drugs, possession of burglary tools, and multiple traffic offenses.

Davaughn Miller was charged with one (1) count of Obstructing Police, a misdemeanor which carries a penalty of up to 93 days in jail, and one (1) count of Disorderly-False Name, a misdemeanor which carries a penalty of up to 93 days in jail. Miller had a felony warrant for his arrest from Kentucky for tampering with a prisoner monitoring device.

Miller's has a lengthy criminal history including convictions for felony arson, kidnapping, dangerous weapons, felony dangerous drugs, carrying a concealed weapon, conspiracy to distribute oxycodone, burglary, possession of a handgun by a convicted felon and receiving stolen property.

On Monday, August 24, 2020, Brittany Mundy was arraigned by the Honorable Magistrate Chisolm from the 44th District Court. Her bond was set for \$25,000.00 Cash/Surety, No 10%. Her next court appearance is scheduled for September 4, 2020, at 8:30 a.m. before Judge Meinecke in the 44th District Court.

On Monday, August 24, 2020, Davaughn Miller was arraigned by the Honorable Magistrate Chisolm from the 44th District Court. His bond was set for \$2,500.00 Cash/Surety, No 10%. His next court appearance is scheduled for September 21, 2020, at 8:30 a.m. before Judge Wittenberg in the 44th District Court.
