Additional Incidents and Information

Suspect Arrested for Operating While Under the Influence of Drugs

On September 11, 2020, approximately 7:50 p.m., Royal Oak Officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle swerving in between the lanes on Woodward near Webster. The driver was acting incoherent and the officers conducted field sobriety evaluations. The driver admitted to smoking marijuana and using prescription drugs. The 44-year-old Warren resident was arrested for operating while under the influence of drugs.

Suspect Arrested for Driving While License Suspended, Felony Warrant, Misdemeanor Warrant, Obstructing, and Narcotic Paraphernalia

On September 13, 2020, approximately 1:10 a.m., Royal Oak Officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle at Stephenson Hwy near E. Fourth St. The driver initially gave a false name to the officer. The driver stated she lied because she did not have a valid license and had warrants for her arrest. The officers located a crack pipe inside the vehicle. The 27-year-old Troy resident was arrested for driving while license suspended, felony and misdemeanor warrants, obstructing-giving false name and narcotic paraphernalia.
