Breaking and Entering

4727 Coolidge Hwy. (BP Gas), 11/30/20, 4:30 a.m. – 4:40 a.m.: Complainant reported an unknown suspect forced entry into the business and stole approximately 20 cartons of cigarettes. 20-41611

On December 4, 2020, at approximately 3:09 a.m., a Royal Oak officer assigned to the Special Investigation Unit was surveilling a suspect from the above November 30, 2020 breaking and entering incident. The suspect attempted to break into the Amoco Gas station at 28610 Woodward and was unsuccessful. He then went to the BP Gas station at 28992 Woodward and broke into the building. The suspect exited the store with a duffle bag of stolen items. Royal Oak officers were able to conduct a traffic stop and arrest the subject.

The 48-year-old Fraser resident was arrested for Breaking & Entering and Possession of Burglar's Tools.

He is suspected to be the same subject in other jurisdictions for the breaking and entering of gas stations.
