- 1) Andrew Mast from Troop 1629: In Tenhave Woods, lined main trails and built the Sassafras Trail (2002)
- 2) James Hutton from Troop 1610: In Cummingston Park, built Meadow, Spicebush and Gentian trails and cleared grapevines from the meadow (2002)
- 3) Steve Eck from Troop 1610: Built and installed 18 birdhouses in Tenhave Woods and Cummingston Park (2003)
- 4) Chris McFadden from Troop 1629: In Tenhave Woods, built and lined Scout and Swamp trails as well as refurbished Sassafras Trail (November 2003)
- 5) Chris Riggs from Troop 1601: Surveyed trees in Royal Oak parks (Dondero, Meininger and Wagner) for Pre-settlement Project (Summer 2003)
- 6) Keegan Springfield from Troop 1707: In Cummingston Park, built the Arkona Trail (October 2004)
- 7) Matt Hoye from Troop 1629: In Cummingston Park, built park entrance way (south end of Leafdale Trail) (November 2005)
- 8) Josh Eggart from Troop 1085: In Tenhave Woods, lined north end of the Sandbar Trail (February 2008)
- 9) Nikolas Hoye from Troop 1629: In Tenhave Woods, made and installed benches and wood duck houses at Dragonfly Pond. Cleared trails, removed flora from the fence along the pond and moved park rule sign from soccer field entrance to the Lexington entrance (April 2008)
- 10) Nolan Tillis from Troop 1627: Buckthorn removal in the arboretum (April 2008)
- 11) Matt Lewan from Troop 1627: Built Fern Trail in Tenhave Woods (June 2008)

- 12) Tyler Jeloneic from Troop 1601: In Tenhave Woods, widened Sassafras trail and moved wildflowers from middle of Sassafras trail to the arboretum (August 2008)
- 13) Jacob Vertel from Troop 1610: In Cummingston Park, built Crawfish Pond (Fall 2008)
- 14) Mike Henning from Troop 1085: In Tenhave Woods, widened and relined Swamp Trail and Scout Trail east of the Swamp Trail (November 2008)
- 15) Ed Goetz from Troop 1610: In Tenhave Woods, added dirt to the trail beginning at the Lexington entrance and built new north half of Pond Trail (beginning at the Sassafras/Pond intersection) (December 2008)
- 16) Stephen Kaurala from Troop 1610: In Tenhave Woods, added 130 cubic feet of dirt to Sassafras, Fern and Pond Trails (October 2009)
- 17) Eric Manidok from Troop 1610: In Tenhave Woods, made and put up trail signs at trail intersections and maps of park on at Lexington and Normandy entrance fences (November 2009)
- 18) Jimmy Kipps from Troop 1627: In Tenhave Woods, rebuilt and lined Scout Trail and parts of Swamp Trail. Added tree ID tags (April 2010)
- 19) Lew Jackson from Troop 1444: In Cummingston Park, lined Leafdale trail, culvert installed at pond, moved entrance gateway, reinstalled park sign and added tree ID tags (June 2010)
- 20) Alex Fabrizo from Troop 1601: In the arboretum, cut down Buckthorn, built new trails. added tree ID tags. In Quickstad, added ID tags just outside of Tenhave Woods Lexington entrance (October 2010)
- 21) Steven Claucherty from Troop 1601: In Tenhave Woods, relined Sandbar Trail between Lexington entrance and Sassafras and a part of Sassafras. Added a bench at Pond Peninsula Trail. Phragmites and Cottonwood control work was done around Dragonfly Pond (November 2010)
- 22) Eric Sylvester from Troop 1085: In the arboretum, Buckthorn removal, added new trails and covering ivy growing on ground with woodchips (April 2011)
- 23) Will Patterson from Troop 1085: In Cummingston Park, relined Gentians, Eagle Scout and Chinquapin Trails. Also put up 11 tree ID tags (September 2011)
- 24) Bryan Wiley from Troop 1629: In Tenhave Woods, added 70 cubic yards of sand on the Fern Trail, Goodwin Trail, at Dragonfly Pond and on the trail inside the Lexington entrance (October 2011)
- 25) Ryan Davis from Troop 1085: In the arboretum, added wood chips onto trails and tree ID tags (November 2011)
- 26) Nate Davis from Troop 1085: In Tenhave Woods, removed vegetation along the west (soccer field) fence (July 2012)
- 27) George Patterson from Troop 1085: In Tenhave Woods, increased height of fence behind homes on Lexington and Custer by about 2 ½ feet by adding 3 wire strands evenly spaced above the existing six foot high fence (October 2012)

28) Nick Jelokek from Troop 1610: In Tenhave Woods, removed invasive Buckthorn and Cottonwood/Silver Maple saplings around Dragonfly Pond. Put-up Wood Duck houses in the swamp, west of the Fern Trail. Also, did some trail lining on the Sassafras Trail, west of Sandbar Trail (November 2013)

29) Dylan Mortimer from Troop 1085: In Tenhave Woods, reworked the Scout and Swamp Trails. Relocated part of Scout Trail to pass near a Pin Oak. Some work was done on Goodwin and Sandbar trails plus installed some tree ID tags (January 2016)

30) James Gibran from Troop 1610: In Cummingston Park, built two new trails west of Leafdale Trail (December 2016)

31) James Richards from Troop 1627: In the arboretum, built mushroom trail, put up street sign trail makers, planted 12 trees and built cage for their protection (April 2017)

32) Peter Swanney from Troop 1610: In Cummingston Park, Meadow clearing, added Blue Bird houses, brush piles for animals and tree ID tags (July 2017)

33). Emery Schroeder from Troop 1634 (Shrine): In the arboretum, finished Mushroom Trail, added blue bird houses, planted 12 trees, and made cages for them, dug up buckthorn (October 2017)

34) Anthony Turner from Troop 1085: In Cummingston, installed three benches at entrance (November 2018)

35) Jaren Wise from Troop 1627: In Cummingston Park, added bridges over some ditches (July 2020)

36) Sebastian Nolte from Troop 1610: In Tenhave Woods, added sand on Pond and Goodwin trails (December 2020)
