Additional Incidents and Information

Delivery Driver Shot During Carjacking

On January 12, 2021, at 9:27 p.m., Royal Oak officers responded to a carjacking in which the driver of the vehicle was shot in the leg.

The victim was delivering groceries to a residence in the 700 block of S. Gainsborough when he was approached by two black males. The suspects demanded the victim's keys, wallet and cellphone. The victim complied and was shot in the leg as he ran away.

Both suspects fled in the victim's vehicle southbound on S. Gainsborough. The victim's vehicle was a gray 2007 Toyota Camry with Michigan license plate 5MPN71.

One suspect is described as a black male, 5'11", 160 pounds. The second suspect is described as a black male, 5'10", 190 pounds. Both suspects are believed to be in their early to mid-twenties.

The victim was transported to WBH with non-life-threatening injuries.

Three Suspects Arrested for Possession of Stolen Property

On January 10, 2021, at 4:44 a.m., officers conducted a traffic stop on a pickup truck without a license plate pulling an enclosed trailer. The officers spoke with the driver and two of his passengers regarding the missing license plate. The officer observed used syringes by the passenger's feet inside the vehicle.

The driver and the occupants were acting very nervously and could not explain who owned the trailer. The officer observed the passenger sitting on a pair of bolt cutters.

The officer discovered the trailer was stolen from a business in Madison Heights. The suspects were heroin users and planned on selling the trailer for drugs.

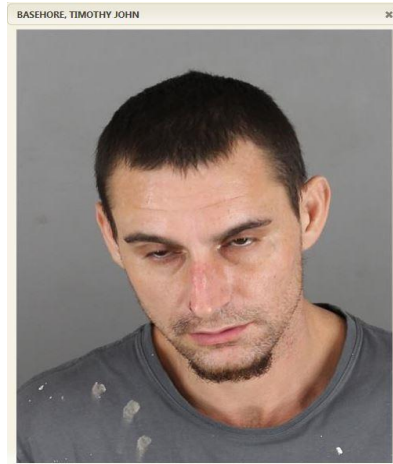
The three suspects from St. Clair Shores, Clinton Township, and Macomb Township were all arrested for receiving and concealing stolen property.

On Tuesday, January 12, 2021, Timothy Basehore, Shane Boden, and Justin Thiel were arraigned before the Honorable Magistrate Chisolm of the 44th District Court. All three suspects were charged with Stolen Property-Receiving & Concealing \$1000 or more but less than \$20,000, a felony which carries imprisonment of up to 5 years in prison.

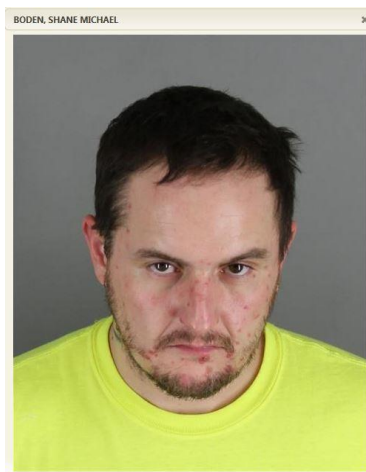
Basehore, Boden and Thiel all had lengthy criminal history including felony delivery/manufacture of controlled substance, felony receiving and concealing stolen property, felony possession of controlled substance, and larceny in a building. Basehore had a misdemeanor warrant for his arrest. Thiel was on probation and had a felony warrant for possession of controlled substance from the 16th Circuit Court.

Basehore and Thiel's bond was set at \$25,000, Cash/Surety 10%. Boden's bond was set at \$15,000, Cash/Surety 10%.

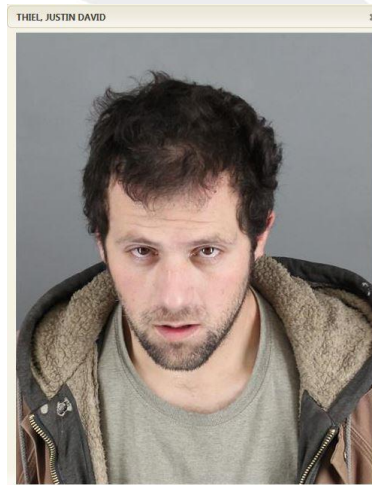
Their next court appearance is set for January 22, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. before the Honorable Judge Meinecke of the 44th District Court.
