## **UPDATE REMINDER-**

The Royal Oak Police Department is nearly complete with our move into the new police station.

During the transition some police operations such as dispatch, prisoner holding, and investigations will occur remotely at Madison Heights Police Department.

Royal Oak residents should not notice any change in service as all phone calls, 911 and general business, will be answered as usual.

The lobby of the current police station will remain open between 8 am and 4 pm every day until the new station is completely up and running.

We expect the new station, located at 450 E. 11 Mile, to be fully operational on Feb 1.
