Additional Incidents and Information

Purse Snatching and Fleeing & Eluding Suspect Arrested

A 62-year-old Troy resident was arrested Saturday evening after Royal Oak officers responded to a call of an armed robbery at Kroger, located at 2200 E. Twelve Mile. On Saturday, March 19, 2022, at approximately 5:00 p.m., the female victim called 911 to report a male suspect had stolen her purse while she was inside the store. Initial reports were that a handgun was seen.

Officers quickly located the suspect's vehicle as it attempted to flee the area. After a brief pursuit, the suspect was taken into custody after losing control of his vehicle in the area of 13 Mile and Crooks. The victim's purse along with suspected narcotic paraphernalia were recovered from the suspect's vehicle.

Investigating officers later determined the purse was taken from an unattended shopping cart and no weapon was implied or seen. No injuries were reported during the incident and the suspect was arrested for Fleeing & Eluding and Larceny in a Building.

Lloyd James Austin is charged with one (1) count of Fleeing and Eluding 3rd Degree, a felony which carries a penalty of up to 5 years in prison and one (1) count of Larceny in a Building, a felony which carries a penalty of 4 years in prison.

Austin's criminal history includes Felony Possession of a Controlled Substance, Criminal Sexual Conduct 2nd Degree, Domestic Violence, Breaking & Entering, Home Invasion 2nd Degree, and Larceny.

On March 22, 2022, Austin was arraigned by the Honorable Magistrate Chisholm from the 44th District Court. Austin's bond was set at \$100,000, No 10%. His next court appearance is scheduled for April 1, 2022, at 9:30 a.m., before the Honorable Judge Meinecke.
