### **Stolen Vehicle – Carrying Concealed Weapon Suspect Arraigned**

The passenger arrested in the incident was formally charged on Sunday. Tasmien Omari-Deshawn Traylor, a resident of Detroit was arraigned on May 29, 2022, before the weekend Honorable Magistrate Chiappelli of the 52<sup>nd</sup> District Court on (1) one count of Carrying Concealed Weapon, a felony which carries a penalty of up to 5 years in prison.

Traylor has no criminal history. His bond was set at \$10,000 Cash/Surety, no 10%. His next scheduled court appearance is June 6, 2022, at 9:00 a.m., before the Honorable Judge Meineke of the 44<sup>th</sup> District Court.

## **Stolen Vehicle – Carrying Concealed Weapon**

On May 27, 2022, at 2:45 p.m., the Royal Oak Police Department received information for a Be On The Lookout (BOLO) from the Troy Police Department regarding a vehicular pursuit on a stolen vehicle. Troy PD terminated the pursuit, and the dark gray Dodge Charger was last seen westbound on 14 Mile, west of Crooks, in the City of Royal Oak.

At 2:46 p.m., Royal Oak Police responded to Coolidge Hwy & 13 Mile for a vehicular crash involving the stolen Dodge Charger. Witnesses reported two subjects fleeing from the vehicle southbound through the Woodward North Apartment complex parking lot.

Officers arrived on scene and established a perimeter with the assistance of Berkley Department of Public Safety and Clawson Police Department. One subject was quickly located and taken into custody and was in possession of a handgun. The second subject remained at large and was last seen running in a southeast direction.

An elementary school in the area was placed in secured mode as a precautionary measure. A K-9 track, and area business searches were conducted with negative results. The second subject from this incident was not located and is described as a younger black male, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt with a possible gray shirt underneath, black track style pants, and black shoes with orange or amber soles.
