Presentation of Organization Activities

RO Nature Society, Ted Vickers: Recently, the High School X-Country Team used Tenhave Woods for running. Geology Walks start on Sunday 11/12/2023. Another program called Mammals of Tenhave is upcoming. For more details, see their website for all activities.

Blessings In A Backpack, Shelley Lake: The program was gifted 32 bins of 18 packed bags each from the company, Ascend Performance Materials in Royal Oak this month. The program also received a \$5,000 gift from Meijer Woodward Corners for which we are grateful. We continue to pack for 150+ students on a weekly basis.

Teen Clean Closet, Kim Johnson: There has been a 22% increase in need for items supplied by the Closet and a 40% decrease in donations. On 11/4/2023 the Royal Oak Optimist Club hosted Trivia night to benefit Teen Clean Closet. One trivia question yielded \$800 in donations to the Closet and donations brought to trivia night totaled \$1,000. During the ICC meeting, Kim received a text from the Community Opportunity Grants fund that they would be a recipient of a \$10,000 grant. Kim was asked to keep this information quiet until it was announced by the Royal Oak City Commission (thus the delay in sending the minutes). On January 24, 2024 they will be meeting with Planet Fitness and on February 24, 2024, the Lions Club is planning an event.

Welcome Inn & Citizens for the Homeless, Shaela Griffin: At the Starr Presbyterian Church the winter program starts on December 4, 2023. There is room for 20-40 guests at the program. Guests will have clothes closet access, a counselor and a warm meal and showers. November is Homeless Awareness Month. A Thanksgiving meal will be served on November 21, 2023.
