






They'll Always Remember . . .

Disregarding the reality of these dreams, the thought that they were able to share them with fellow students is enough to spark a vivid remembrance of the past.







Their Class Time Hours

When considering the people and the experiences which made up the school year, one always thinks about the classroom. Because the students spent so much time in the classroom, the new methods of teaching showed increased student interest.


Although teachers have also experienced the rush of busy years in the classroom, they still return, hoping to diversify their interests as well as improving ours.












The business and home economic courses at Dondero prepare students for what is to come upon entering the business and domestic worlds. By learning the fundamentals of these



These students have performed for many organizations, and all concerts have shown fine results. The school and the community have enjoyed their outstanding performances.











Under the superb direction of Miss Harriet Levi with help from choreographers Michelle Allen, Patti Peters, and Ruthann Hellman, the cast was molded into shape. Music was provided by the Dondero Orchestra, directed by Mr. Joseph Parker, and the piano by John Zussman.

This musical extravaganza started off with the initial tryouts lasting two weeks, followed by two days of semi-finals. The cast and chorus were chosen by an experienced panel of judges including Mr. Hartsoe, Miss Levi, Mr. MacGregor, Noreen McKinder, Mr. Stout, and Mrs. Nelson. Miss Carlyn James with help from Eric Cowley and Gail Pfeiffer, constructed the professional-looking scenery.

The crowds were unbelievable! "Standing Room Only" read the sign on the ticket booth. Hundreds of people were turned away every night. Advertising for "Bye Bye Birdie" was also fabulous. Thousands of posters were put up in the halls. A billboard, announcing the dates of the play, was rented at Thirteen Mile and Woodward. The leads also made their T.V. debut on Robin Seymour's dance program, "Swingin' Time"! "Birdie" reached a new high in school play productions.







Dondero Nominates Rockefeller






Thru the Pool There Came Familiar Swimming







Oaks Kindle Kimball!

This years football team ended with a 3-win, 4-loss, 2-tie season obviously going into their last game as the underdog. But in the first quarter Jerry Campbell scored Dondero's first touchdown. It was a scoreless second quarter with Kimball scoring their first 7 in the third period. Then in the final quarter Rodger Duty took the ball over the goal line for the final score. 
